

# HUNGER IN CLARK COUNTY

## Food Insecurity

In Clark County 77,633 residents are food insecure. This means 1 in 5 of the county's population are unsure of where their next meal will come from.



## Food Bank Participation

Clark County food banks receiving funds from the WSDA Food Assistance Program served 86,669 people in need of food last year. These people visited food banks 354,775 times to get nutritious foods including meats, dairy, produce and grains.

## Poverty Rate

In Clark County it is estimated that over 10% of people are living under the poverty levels. An income at the poverty level is not enough for families and individuals in Washington to survive. According to the USDA Food and Nutrition Services Department the poverty level for a family of 2 is less than \$14,580 a year and \$22,056 for a family of 4.
